Bookstack

This wiki uses a system called **BookStack**. It's like a library: All content is organized into **books**. Books have pages with text, images or videos. It's different from other wikis, but simple!

Here's a description from the official website.

What is Bookstack?

A platform for storing and organising information and documentation. Details for BookStack can be found on the official website at <https://www.bookstackapp.com/>.

BookStack is an opinionated wiki system that provides a pleasant and simple out-of-the-box experience. New users to an instance should find the experience intuitive and only basic word-processing skills should be required to get involved in creating content on BookStack. The platform should provide advanced power features to those that desire it but they should not interfere with the core simple user experience.

BookStack is not designed as an extensible platform to be used for purposes that differ to the statement above.

In regard to development philosophy, BookStack has a relaxed, open & positive approach. At the end of the day this is free software developed and maintained by people donating their own free time.

How is content organized?

The principles of storing information within BookStack is based of the ideas of a normal stack of books. Just like normal books, BookStack books can contain chapters and pages. You start off by creating a book which acts as the highest level of categorisation. Ideally you'd have separate books for separate topics.

Within a book you can directly create pages or you can first create chapters. Chapters provide an additional level of page grouping to keep pages organised but are optional. All the information you write is held within pages. Although books and chapters do not hold information they can be given a short description to assist with searching and visibility.

Once you start to stack-up books you can start to use Bookshelves to organise your Books. Bookshelves can contain multiple books and a single book could be placed on multiple Bookshelves.

Adding your own book

Adding your own book is easy! Here's how to get started.


1. **Create an account** to get started.
2. **Create a book** by going to 'Books' and selecting 'Create new Book'.
 - Give your book a nice name, thumbnail, and [some tags](#) (optional)
3. **Add pages** to your book to fill it with content.
 - You're looking at a page right now! Pages can contain text, images, videos and more.
 - You can also create chapters to organize your pages.
 - If each page of your book covers very different topics, [consider tagging them!](#)

4. The '**Books**' tab will contain your book, for everyone to see.
 - Collaborators can add your Book to a **Shelf** to make it even easier to find.
5. **Check the [style guide](#)** if you're unsure of how you should write your pages.

You did it! If your book is of high quality, an admin may add it to the curated [community shelf](#).

Before you go, here's a quick reminder of how BookStack (the wiki platform we use) is structured:

- **Shelves** contain books.
 - Only admins can manage shelves
 - Books do not need to be in a shelf. They can also be in multiple shelves.
- **Books** are created by users.
 - Only the user who created a book can manage it.
- **Pages** are contained in books. Pages can be organized into **Chapters**.



One more thing: Each Bookshelf, Book, Chapter and Page, can also have **Tags**. Visitors can click on a tag to see other content with that tag! [Read our guide on how to tag your content.](#)

Book Style Guide

The entire wiki is still a work-in-progress! These guidelines are subject to change. If you have a suggestion, let us know!

We invite anyone to share their knowledge on VRCLibrary.com. Please follow these guidelines when submitting content.

TL;DR

1. Focus on sharing knowledge.
2. Your content should relate to VRChat world or avatar creation.
3. Respect the platform, don't be malicious.
4. Organize your content, make it readable.
5. When collaborating with other users, communicate and set a good example.

We also reserve the right to remove books if they are of low quality (or very out of date).

Personal Books

All VRCLibrary.com users can create their own books, to share guides, personal experiences, or other knowledge you'd like to share with a wider audience. As the author of the book, you are responsible for its content - other users cannot modify it, and admins will not edit your content (except for moderation and tagging purposes). When creating your book, keep the following things in mind:

Share your knowledge

This wiki is meant as a resource for people to learn and share their VRChat knowledge. Try to keep that in mind when structuring your content! For example, books can be...

- Guides and Tutorials. These can be beginner-focused, or go *in-depth* on expert topics!
- Educational resources or knowledge to better understand VRChat, Unity or Social VR as a platform.
- "Blog"-style pages for sharing personal insights. What have you learned from your mistakes and successes?

If your book isn't focused on sharing knowledge, it's probably not a good fit for this wiki.

It's about VRChat content creation

If it's related to the creation of VRChat worlds or avatars, and you'd like to share your knowledge - then it's probably a good fit for the wiki! Your book could cover topics such as...

- **Unity:** Udon, world creation, light baking, animation, world design, etc.
- **Tools:** Blender, Udon, Substance, Git, Audacity, etc.
- **Design:** Design documents, workflows, post-mortems, dev logs, etc.
- **Community:** Marketing your content, managing a community, dealing with feedback, etc.

It's totally OK if your book has knowledge that is useful outside VRChat. However, don't submit content that isn't related to the **creation** of VRChat content. For example, this isn't a place for sharing your thoughts and grudges about people or groups of people!

We currently don't have specific rules on self-promotion. But we must ask that you respect VRCLibrary's community and readers. Don't be malicious!

Keeping things organized

Please structure your content in a way that integrates well into the wiki. This can be difficult to get right, but here's a few tips:

Books about a single topic

- Great if you're covering something long or complex that requires multiple pages.
- If you add tags to the book itself, you may not need to add tags to chapters or pages.
- For example, Silent's "[Standard Shader and You](#)" is great for anyone wanting to get in-depth knowledge about Unity's standard shader.

Books about multiple topics

- Good if you're sharing bite-sized information about different types of topics that are too small for their own book.
- Make sure to tag each page of your book. Otherwise it might be difficult for users to find your content.
- For example, Fax has a book about [various worlds and prefabs he's made](#).

Collaborative Books

If you've received permission from a moderator, you can edit the content of collaborative books. You're looking at a collaborative book *right now*! These follow the same rules as personal books, but here's some additional things to consider:

- Use the "Set changelog" feature when editing a page. This makes it easier for other collaborators to understand what you've changed.
- Keep in touch with other collaborators and the community!
- We expect your content to be of a higher standard than personal books.


In conclusion


How to tag your content

Tagging your content makes it much easier to find via the search bar. Users can also click a tag to instantly find similar content.

Any page or book can have tags and sub-tags. Here's some examples:



When editing a page, check the right hand side of your screen to add tags. (Books use a different interface)



Click the 'tag name' field to see tags which tag types already exist. For example, you could add the 'Category' -> 'Unity' tag.

Tags are difficult for moderators to curate. Before adding your own, new, custom, shiny tag - consider checking what tags already exist. For example, if your page is about Unity lightmapping, consider adding the "Unity" - "Lightmapping" tag!

Support / Troubleshooting

Where's my confirmation email?

Check your spam folder! VRCLibrary.com is relatively new, and our confirmation emails are likely to get filtered by your email provider. If you're struggling with email registration, consider registering in via Discord, or contact our staff.

How do I restore a page I deleted?

Deleted content is kept for up to 30 days. Contact our Discord staff to have your content restored. Just, uh, try to be more careful next time!

How do I delete my account?

In the top right, click on your name, then on 'Edit Profile'. In your profile page, select 'delete user'. You will be asked to confirm your account deletion. If you've created any pages, you may decide which user should receive ownership of your pages.

If you've submitted personal books to VRCLibrary, you may ask us to remove them.

How does [...] work on the wiki?

VRCLibrary uses the [Bookstack](#) wiki system. Their community is quite active, so you'll probably find the answer over there!

Code of Conduct
